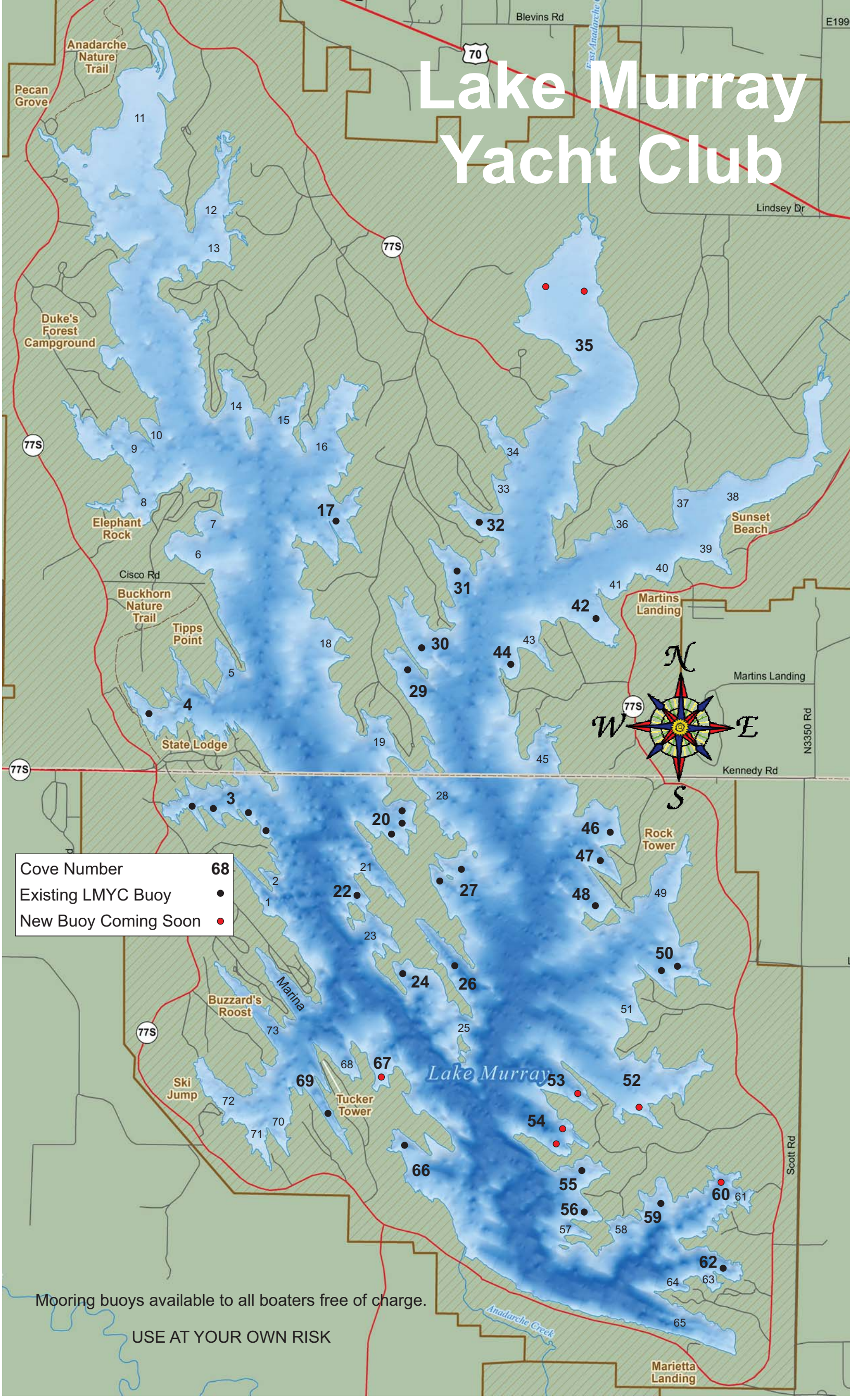

New Marina Entrance Marker Lights

If you have been out after dark, you have probably noticed the new red and green flashing lights marking the entrance to the marina.

During June 2016, LMYC worked with the Marina and Oklahoma Highway Patrol to design and locate the new buoys and lights.

LMYC purchased the lights and anchoring systems and assisted Marina personnel in deploying the new buoys and lights.



Supporting Search and Rescue



LMYC purchased a Hummingbird 360 Side Imaging Sonar for use with Search and Rescue at the Lake.

Oklahoma Highway Patrol maintains the equipment at the ready in the event Rescue efforts are needed.

DID YOU KNOW.... The mooring buoys located around Lake Murray were deployed by the Lake Murray Yacht Club. In cooperation with the State Park and the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, LMYC maintains and repairs the existing buoys around the lake. Recently, new buoys have been approved in 8 locations (as shown on the map on the reverse side).

This year, an LMYC diver has inspected the anchor and tether on all the existing buoys. Over 2/3 of the existing buoys have been fit with a new 1/2" wire rope tether.



During the remainder of 2016, the existing buoys will be getting a face lift with new numbers and stripes.

The buoys are available for use by all boaters, free of charge.
